SOMETHING YOU MUST KNOW:

God is perfect. He is Holy. We are all sinners. *For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.*

(Romans 3:23a KJB)

None of us could ever make ourselves perfect or holy to be accepted by God. But God loves us all so much, that He gave His only Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, to go to the cross and pay the penalty for our sins IN FULL, ONCE and FOR ALL. Jesus died and rose again. Because of the Lord Jesus Christ, God can now make us holy and acceptable to Himself. *For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit.* (1 Peter 3:18 KJB)

Jesus Christ is our ONLY WAY to God and heaven.

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life, no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

(John 14:6 KJB)

Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved. (Acts 16:31 KJB)

Without Jesus Christ, you can NEVER be accepted by God or go to heaven. When you believe in Jesus Christ as your Savior, God makes you His child. When you leave this world, you will spend all of eternity with Him! *But as many as received him to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name.* (John 1:12 KJB) While you are still here on earth, learn His beautiful Word. Believe it and obey it, so you can enjoy all God has done for you.

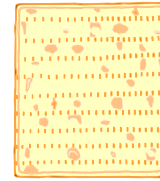
Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom.

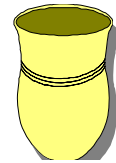
Today is the day that we

EAT THE BREAD



and

DRINK THE CUP



to do something
REALLY IMPORTANT!

What is this this really important thing we SHOULD do when we eat the bread & drink the cup? Let's see what Jesus told us we SHOULD be doing:

"And when he (Jesus) had given thanks, he brake *it*, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me."

After the same manner also *he took* the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as often as ye drink *it*, in remembrance of me."

For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this

cup, ye do shew (proclaim) the Lord's death till
he come." 1Corinthians 11:24-26 KJB

The underlined words in those scriptures tell us what
Jesus said we SHOULD do when we eat the bread &
drink the cup.

“THIS DO IN REMEMBRANCE OF ME!”

When we celebrate the Lord's supper it is a very
JOYOUS but SERIOUS celebration. Our minds
should NOT be thinking of other things. We should
REMEMBER JESUS!

Jesus considers REMEMBERING HIM really im-
portant! Jesus considers REMEMBERING what He
did for us by dying on the cross really important.

What did He do on the cross?



“Who his own self bare our sins in his
own body on the tree, that we, being
dead to sins should live unto
righteousness.”

1Peter 2:24 KJB

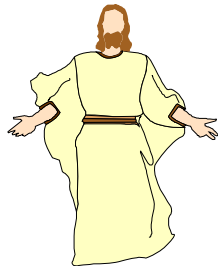
We deserved the punishment of God's wrath for our
sins; but Jesus loves us so much that He took our
place there on that cross 2000 years ago. In His
sinless, perfect human body, Jesus suffered the agony
of God's wrath for our sins. It was a suffering that
was so awful, that when God poured out His punish-
ment for sins upon Jesus, it was the ONLY TIME
that Jesus cried out in pain. We should NEVER
take Jesus or His death on the cross and His resurrec-

tion for granted. He is the one who took our sins AWAY forever! We could NEVER do anything to take our sins out of the way. But now, no one's sins stand between them & God because Jesus paid for ALL of them on the cross. Now JESUS ALONE stands between God & man. All a person has to do is BELIEVE IN JESUS & that person is FORGIVEN FOREVER. All a person has to do is BELIEVE IN JESUS & that person is entered into God's FAMILY FOREVER! That is the most important thing we should CELEBRATE & REMEMBER about Jesus as we eat the bread & drink the cup.

But there is something else we should also REMEMBER about Jesus that will help us appreciate & celebrate the Lord's Supper. What is that something else? We should

REMEMBER WHO HE IS!

And so for today's lesson, we will look at a few scriptures that TELL us who He is so we can REMEMBER HIM even better all the time & especially at the Lord's Supper! Who is Jesus? Read what Jesus told His disciple Philip when Philip asked Jesus to show him & the other disciples God.



"...he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou *then*, Shew us the Father?"

John 14:9c KJB

Jesus told Philip that anyone that has seen Jesus has seen God the Father!!! Why??? Because

JESUS IS GOD!

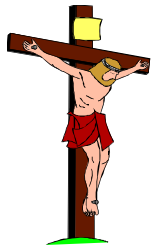
So as we eat the bread & drink the cup, REMEMBER that JESUS IS GOD! Titus 2:13-14 KJB also CLEARLY tells us that JESUS IS GOD; but notice what else the scripture tells us about

WHO JESUS IS!

“Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

Who gave himself for us that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.”

Boy oh boy! THAT scripture sure is CLEAR about WHO JESUS IS! In fact, it can't be said any CLEARER! That scripture tells us that



JESUS IS GOD
AND OUR SAVIOR!
HE DIED & ROSE AGAIN
FOR YOU!

Jesus died & rose again to
make us the way to God.



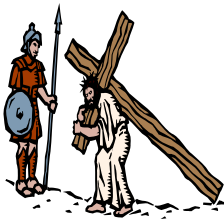
And Jesus, our God & Savior, will return someday.

He will come to earth as God our KING!

By the way, did you know that some “religions” say that the Bible does NOT clearly state that Jesus IS GOD! Well, those RELIGIONS sure are WRONG! And this scripture in our King James Bible PROVES they are wrong. (Always make certain you use the King James Bible because all the other translations DO NOT have every Word of God in them.) It

might be a good idea for you to REMEMBER both the number & the words of that scripture so you will be READY with the TRUTH should anyone try to tell you the LIE that the bible never says that Jesus is God! (Remember though, ALWAYS tell the TRUTH in a POLITE way. God may be using YOU to lead others to Christ. So DO NOT speak rudely. Speak the TRUTH about JESUS in LOVE! Read this in Isaiah 50:4 & Colossians 4:2-6!)

Jesus ALWAYS EXISTED because He is God; and God is the ONLY ONE who has no beginning & no end. God is ETERNAL! Jesus is ETERNAL GOD; yet He left His throne of glory to come to the earth to take upon Him a perfect human body so that He could DIE on the cross to pay for the sins of EVERY MAN, WOMAN & CHILD! For YOU & for ME! Philippians 2:5-11 & Hebrews 2:9 are 2 more scriptures that you should REMEMBER & LEARN BY HEART so you can understand the



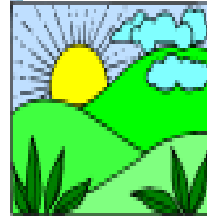
AWESOME LOVE

that God has for you that He should come to earth to SUFFER & DIE FOR YOU! All these scriptures are good to learn by heart in order that you can be READY WITH THE TRUTH about Jesus should God give you the privilege to tell someone else about Jesus so that they too might be saved. Jesus is the ONLY SAVIOR! 1Timothy 2:3-6 KJB & John 14:6 KJB tell us this fact!

As we eat the bread & drink the cup, REMEMBER that JESUS IS GOD YOUR SAVIOR! Remember how much He LOVES you to have come

down from heaven to take your place on the cross!
What else should we REMEMBER about Jesus as
we celebrate the Lord's Supper? Read this scripture
which speaks of Jesus Christ:

"For by him were all things cre-
ated, that are in heaven, and that
are in earth, visible and invisible,
whether *the be* thrones, or domin-
ions, or principalities, or powers:



all things were created by him, and for him."

And he is before all things, and by him all
things consist."

Colossians 1:16-17 KJB

JESUS IS THE CREATOR OF EVERYTHING!

No one created Jesus. Jesus created everything!

That scripture also tells us that Jesus is the One who
is keeping all the things He created going! Jesus is
the One who commands the sun, moon & stars to stay where
they are! He commands the oceans to stay where they are!
See Proverbs 8:29; Psalms 147:4-5; Luke 8:22-24. If it were
not for Jesus, our world would NEVER have come to be. If
it were not for Jesus, our world would long ago have been de-
stroyed! And think about this: Jesus the CREATOR
made the very tree upon which He was crucified!

Jesus the CREATOR created the very people who
hated Him & nailed Him to that tree! And He DIED
for those people too! Oh! How very much Jesus
LOVES US! Ecclesiastes 12:1 tells us to REMEMBER
our CREATOR! There are many more things we
should know about WHO JESUS IS, but for today, as
we eat the bread & drink the cup, let us

REMEMBER these 3:

JESUS IS GOD OUR SAVIOR & CREATOR!

Directions

From I-95

- RI Exit #22; *Left* at split to **Rt. 6 W.**
- Take Killingly St (Rt. 128) Exit; *Right* off Exit.
- Take Killingly to end; *Right* on Manton Ave; cross bridge.
- Turn *Left* at light (CVS on corner), and then bear *Left* at the split. You are now on Woonasquatucket Ave.
- Go about 1 mi.
- **G.C.F.** is on the *Left*.

From Rt. 146

- Mineral Spring Ave Exit in Providence.
- From **146 N** turn *Left* off Exit; from **146 S** turn *Right*.
- Take Mineral Spring to end and stay *Left* around the rotary (pass North Providence Town Hall).
- Take next *Right* onto Woonasquatucket Ave.
- Go about 1½ mi.
- **G.C.F.** is on the *Right*.
