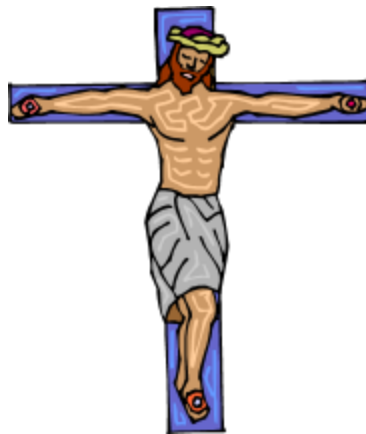

## **SOMETHING YOU MUST KNOW:**

God is perfect. He is Holy. We are all sinners. *For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.*

(Romans 3:23a KJB)

None of us could ever make ourselves perfect or holy to be accepted by God. But God loves us all so much, that He gave His only Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, to go to the cross and pay the penalty for our sins IN FULL, ONCE and FOR ALL. Jesus died and rose again. Because of the Lord Jesus Christ, God can now make us holy and acceptable to Himself. *For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit.* (1 Peter 3:18 KJB)

Jesus Christ is our ONLY WAY to God and heaven.

*Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life, no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.*

(John 14:6 KJB)

*Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved.* (Acts 16:31 KJB)

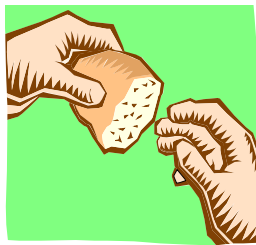

## WELCOME TO THE LORD'S SUPPER!

On the night before He died, Jesus told the apostles many important things about Himself & why He was going to be crucified. That night, Jesus & His apostles celebrated a special Jewish feast called PASSOVER. (We'll learn about this very important Jewish feast in future lessons.) Something very important happened at that Passover supper.



Here is what happened:

"And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed *it*, and brake *it*, and gave *it* to the disciples, and said, Take, eat;

this is my body."

Matthew 26:26 KJB

What did Jesus do with the bread?

After Jesus told the disciples to EAT the bread, what did else did Jesus tell them about the bread?

"this is m \_ b \_ \_ y.

Did Jesus mean that the bread was really his body? Of course not. Jesus was sitting right there at the table with His disciples. That bread was NOT His

real body. It was a SYMBOL of Jesus' body. That bread was a SYMBOL to help the disciples (and us also) REMEMBER how Jesus' body was beaten & tortured & then nailed to the cross by the Roman soldiers. But that bread also helps us to REMEMBER the most important FACT of all about why Jesus' body was broken for us. Read this next scripture about Jesus to find out what that most important fact is:



"Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree..."

1Peter 2:24 KJB

Now after Jesus blessed & broke the bread & told His disciples to take & eat it, here is what Jesus did next:



"And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them saying, Drink ye all of it:

For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins."

Matthew 26:28 KJB

What did Jesus do with the cup?

After Jesus told all the disciples to drink of the cup,

what else did Jesus tell them about the cup?

Did Jesus mean that the cup was really his blood?  
Of course not. Jesus was sitting right there at the table with His disciples. That cup was NOT His real blood. It was a SYMBOL of Jesus’ blood. That cup was a SYMBOL to help the disciples (and us also) REMEMBER why Jesus shed His blood on the



cross. Jesus told His disciples & us why He shed His blood. Here is what Jesus said:

For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.”

Matthew 26:28b KJB

Jesus told His disciples that He would shed His blood on the cross for the re \_ \_ \_ s \_ o \_ of sins.

The word “remission” means “to send off” or “to send away”. In other scriptures that word for remission is also translated as the word forgiveness.

Jesus gave us the reason why He shed His blood on the cross.

It is so important that we remember these FACTS about Jesus, that Jesus gave us the BREAD & the CUP which are things that we can see, touch, feel, smell & taste to help us REMEMBER why He died on the cross. In fact, Jesus told the apostle Paul this about those symbols:

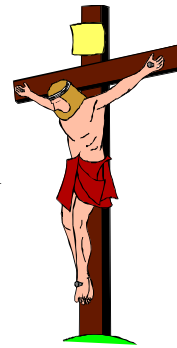
“For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew (proclaim, show, teach) the Lord’s death till he come.” 1Corinthians 11:26 KJB  
Jesus told His disciples that every time we eat the bread that represents His broken body & drink the cup that represents His blood which was shed for the remission of sins, we show or proclaim or teach His death until He comes back to earth again someday.

Why did Jesus die on the cross 2000 years ago?

The Lord had the apostle Paul write down the reason. Here is what the apostle Paul wrote:

“For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;

And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures.” 1Corinthians 15:3-4 KJB



The apostle Paul tells us that these facts which we just read there in 1Corinthians 15:3-4 are called the GOSPEL. What does that word GOSPEL mean? It means GOOD NEWS or A GOOD MESSAGE! Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-4 again. Now answer the questions using words from that scripture. The answers to these questions are the 3 most important parts of the GOSPEL—the GOOD NEWS.

The apostle Paul said that Christ died for “our” sins. Today we will look at some scriptures that tell us who Jesus died for when His body was broken & His blood was shed on the cross 2000 years ago. On the line under each scripture write in the word or words that tell us for whom Jesus died 2000 years ago.

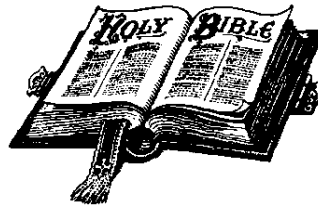
Romans 5:6 KJB

“For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.”

What does that word “ungodly” mean?

People who are “ungodly” have no respect for God. It means sinners. Romans 5:6 tells us that Jesus died for us when we were “ungodly”. Romans 3:10 & 23 & Ephesians 2:1-3 are just 3 scriptures that tell us that we ALL start out in this world as “ungodly”.



Romans 5:7-8

KJB

“For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would

even dare to die.

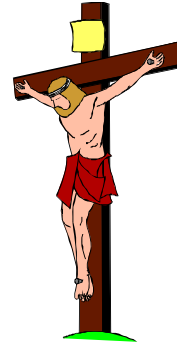
But God commendeth (showed or exhibited) his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

Christ died for us while we were yet \_ \_ \_ \_ \_ .  
So we see then that Christ died for "ungodly" sinners which we ALL come into this world as.

Now lets' read a few more scriptures that tell us for whom Jesus died 2000 years ago.

John 3:16 KJB

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life."



Christ died for the \_ \_ \_ \_ \_ .

1 Timothy 2:5-6

"For *there* is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time."

This scripture tells us what Jesus did by His death on the cross.

"Christ, Jesus gave himself a ransom."

What does that word "ransom" mean? It means that on the cross, Jesus PAID the debt for sins. That



word also comes from another word that means “substitute”. This scripture tells us that on the cross Jesus paid God a debt that was owed for sins. Now Jesus NEVER sinned.

So whose sins did Jesus pay?  
Jesus “gave himself a ransom for \_ \_ \_,”

These are just a few scriptures that tell us for whom Jesus died. He died to pay for the sins:

for the “ungodly”  
for sinners  
for the world  
for all

Jesus died for YOU—no matter who you are or what you have done. He has paid for all of our sins. He tells us so in the GOSPEL—THE GOOD NEWS:

“For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received,  
how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;

And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures.” 1Corinthians 15:3-4 KJB



What does God want us to do with His GOOD NEWS?

If you have never heard it before, God wants you simply to BELIEVE IT! And if you simply BELIEVE IT, He will save you from the Lake of Fire & make you His child forever! If you do NOT believe it, then you will spend eternity suffering in that Lake of Fire forever away from

## Directions

### From I-95

- RI Exit #22; *Left* at split to **Rt. 6 W.**
- Take Killingly St (Rt. 128) Exit; *Right* off Exit.
- Take Killingly to end; *Right* on Manton Ave; cross bridge.
- Turn *Left* at light (CVS on corner), and then bear *Left* at the split. You are now on Woonasquatucket Ave.
- Go about 1 mi.
- **G.C.F.** is on the *Left*.

### From Rt. 146

- Mineral Spring Ave Exit in Providence.
- From **146 N** turn *Left* off Exit; from **146 S** turn *Right*.
- Take Mineral Spring to end and stay *Left* around the rotary (pass North Providence Town Hall).
- Take next *Right* onto Woonasquatucket Ave.
- Go about 1½ mi.
- **G.C.F.** is on the *Right*.
