QUESTIONS are Helpful!





SOMETHING YOU MUST KNOW:

God is perfect. He is Holy. We are all sinners. *For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.*

(Romans 3:23a KJB)

None of us could ever make ourselves perfect or holy to be accepted by God. But God loves us all so much, that He gave His only Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, to go to the cross and pay the penalty for our sins IN FULL, ONCE and FOR ALL. Jesus died and rose again. Because of the Lord Jesus Christ, God can now make us holy and acceptable to Himself. *For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit.* (1 Peter 3:18 KJB)

Jesus Christ is our ONLY WAY to God and heaven.

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life, no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

(John 14:6 KJB)

Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved. (Acts 16:31 KJB)

Without Jesus Christ, you can NEVER be accepted by God or go to heaven. When you believe in Jesus Christ as your Savior, God makes you His child. When you leave this world, you will spend all of eternity with Him! *But as many as received him to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name*. (John 1:12 KJB) While you are still here on earth, learn His beautiful Word. Believe it and obey it, so you can enjoy all God has done for you.

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom. (Colossians 3:16a KJB)





Questions are wonderful tools! Questions help teachers teach. Questions help students learn! God knows how very important questions are. And by the way, God is the ONLY ONE who has all the 100% CORRECT ANSWERS! When Jesus was on this earth, He USED questions when He taught. He used the questions which OTHERS ASKED HIM to teach them about God, about life, about Himself in the answers that HE gave them. Jesus also ASKED questions. But He did NOT ask these questions because He did not know the answer. Jesus is God. He knew all the answers perfectly. So why did Jesus ask questions?

Sometimes Jesus asked questions to let certain people who thought they knew everything realize that they did NOT know everything. For example, in Jesus' day, there was a group of men called Pharisees. These Pharisees were very EDUCATED & RELIGIOUS but VERY PROUD & ARROGANT! They thought they knew everything about God. They thought they were BETTER than other people. Jesus OFTEN asked these religious Pharisees lots of the kind of questions that show people that they do NOT know everything! In Matthew 22:41-46 we find an example of how Jesus USED questions to

show the proud Pharisees that they did NOT know everything about God!

"While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them,



Saying, what think ye of Christ?

Whose son is he? They say unto him, *The Son* of David,"

The Pharisees answered this question correctly. You see, David was a very important ancestor of Christ. But now Jesus asks these Pharisees a few more questions which they COULD NOT ANSWER! Here is what Jesus asked next:

He saith unto them, How then doth David in spirit call him Lord, saying,

The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand till I make thine enemies thy foot-stool?

If David then call him Lord, how is he his son?

This was a difficult question for the Pharisees to answer. These Pharisees knew what the scriptures said about Christ being the son of David. But you see, even though Christ was born physically into the family line of the famous King David, King of Israel (Read Matthew 1:1 & Luke 3:23-31 to see this fact.), Christ was ALSO David's GOD—HIS LORD! Now the EDUCATED PHARISEES found this VERY DIFFI- CULT to understand. And they certainly did NOT believe that CHRIST, the SON of DAVID was actually Jesus who was standing in a body of flesh right before their very eyes & talking to them, asking them these questions! These Pharisees did NOT believe that Christ had left heaven to enter in to a human

body. So when Jesus asked them how Christ could be David's LORD & David's son (descendant) at the SAME TIME, here is what happened.

"And <u>no man was able to answer</u> <u>him a word</u>, and neither durst any *man* from that day forth ask him any more *questions*."

And as YOU read Jesus' answers to the questions others asked Him , YOU will learn more & more TRUTH about Jesus, yourself, life, heaven & other important FACTS that God wants you to know! In fact, God's written Word has EVERYTHING YOU



NEED TO KNOW about God, about this life & about eternity! Here is what one man wrote long ago about God's Word:

"O how love I thy <u>law</u>! It *is* my meditation all the day. Thou through thy <u>command-</u>

ments hast made me wiser than mine enemies: for they are ever with me.

I have more understanding than all my teachers: for thy <u>testimonies</u> *are* my meditation.

I understand more than the ancients, because I keep thy <u>precepts</u>. I have refrained my feet from every evil way, that I might keep thy <u>word</u>.

I have not departed from thy judgments: for thou hast taught me.

How sweet are thy <u>words</u> unto my taste! *Yea*, sweeter than honey to my mouth!


Through thy <u>precepts</u> I get understanding: therefore I hate every false way.

"And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

All scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

That the man of God may be perfect (Perfect here means very mature or grown up in the way they think, speak, act. It does NOT mean they are sinless!) throughly furnished unto all good works."

2Timothy 3:15-17 KJB


